## Place two bins out for collection each week:



Keep bins one metre clear of obstructions and within one metre of the road.

- FOGO (lime green lid) + RECYCLING (yellow lid) week
- FOGO (lime green lid) + GENERAL WASTE (red lid) week
- Bins collected a day later due to public holiday.
- Additional Christmas collections, all three bins collected during this period.

**Need more FOGO kitchen caddy liners?**  
 Vouchers to collect two free rolls of liners are provided on your rates notice. If you purchase liners, make sure they display the seedling symbol (AS 4736).




# Services

## BOOKED SKIP BINS & ITEM COLLECTIONS

### Skip bins

Each financial year, residents will be eligible to order

- 1x General Waste skip bin
- and
- 1x Greenwaste skip bin.

Skip bins are:

1.8m long x 1.65m wide x 1.2m tall

### Mattresses, fridges and lounges

Each financial year, residents can book up to three (3) on-demand item collections for mattresses, fridges/ freezers or lounges.

- ✓ Remove doors from fridges and freezers before placing on the verge
- ✓ Fridges and freezers do not need to be degassed prior to collection

## FREE DROP-OFF ITEMS

- ✓ Empty aerosol cans
- ✓ 20L waste oil
- ✓ 20L waste chemicals (includes paint) *\*Red Hill only*
- ✓ Polystyrene *\*Baywaste only*

Lime-green Lid  
COLLECTED WEEKLY

Only compostable items and liners with the seedling logo should be placed in this bin.

# RECYCLING BIN

Yellow Lid  
COLLECTED FORTNIGHTLY

Place all items loose in the bin. Flatten cardboard, rinse containers and remove lids.



Cans



Cardboard (flattened)



Glass



Paper (not shredded)



Plastic bottles (lids off)



**Recycle the five!**

Keep it simple and remember these 5: paper, cardboard, cans, plastic and glass.

# GENERAL WASTE BIN

Red Lid  
COLLECTED FORTNIGHTLY

General household waste items are to be placed in this bin.



Soft plastics



Foil lined cartons



Single use cups and lids



Nappies, sanitary products



Damaged clothing and textiles



**Avoid excess packaging**

Some items can't be recovered by gifting, recycling or other means. We can do better by AVOIDING these items in the first place!

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

The following items should never be placed in any bin. They should be taken to an appropriate drop off location.

- Batteries
- E-cigarettes and vapes
- Fire extinguishers (red only)
- Flammables and corrosives
- Fluorescent globes and tubes
- Gas cylinders and aerosols
- Household and pool chemicals
- Pesticides and herbicides

Remember to Take items to drop-off points!  
**TAKING** items to specialised recovery points is easier than we might think.
